-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, cut down to the ground, the branches that have produced fruit (dried out). Keep 7-10 young shoots planted a metre apart.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : breeder Elwyn W. Meader (Gb) 1964
-  **Use group:** Fruit Trees
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
