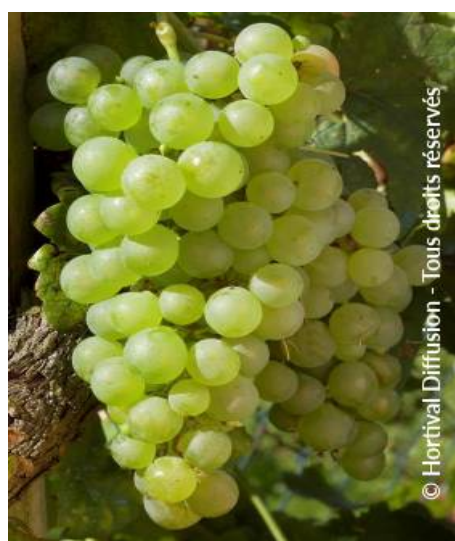


VITIS vinifera 'CHASSELAS DE FONTAINEBLEAU'

Chasselas de Fontainebleau' Grape Vine



Dessert grape - large white grapes.



Maintenance advice: Attach principal branches to a trellis. At the end of winter, shorten branches to above the third bud. In summer, trim any new branches regularly to allow the sun to colour the grapes, and to control vegetation.
