-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, remove any dead wood and incumbent branches, too low or too spread out, if necessary. Water abundantly and regularly for the first 2 years.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : imported from Siberia by N. E. Hansen (US) around 1920
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 4 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** tree like
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** White/pink
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Free standing specimen, Border, Country hedge
