


ACER palmatum 'SHISHIGASHIRA'

Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, cut down any dead wood. Pruning, not always necessary, can be done moderately, at the end of summer/beginning of autumn. Protect the bigger sized wounds (bigger than a finger) with a special pruning sealer.
