Maintenance advice: After flowering, find and cut down the non flowering branches, leaving just 2-3 buds. Shorten other less flowering branches, to just above a leaf bud, to rejuvenate.

- Pinch the young shoots (break off between fingers while soft, or cut off, to shorten by about a half), all along the branches, to help floral buds to develop the following year. Treat with antileaf curl, once leaves have fallen, to strengthen.
