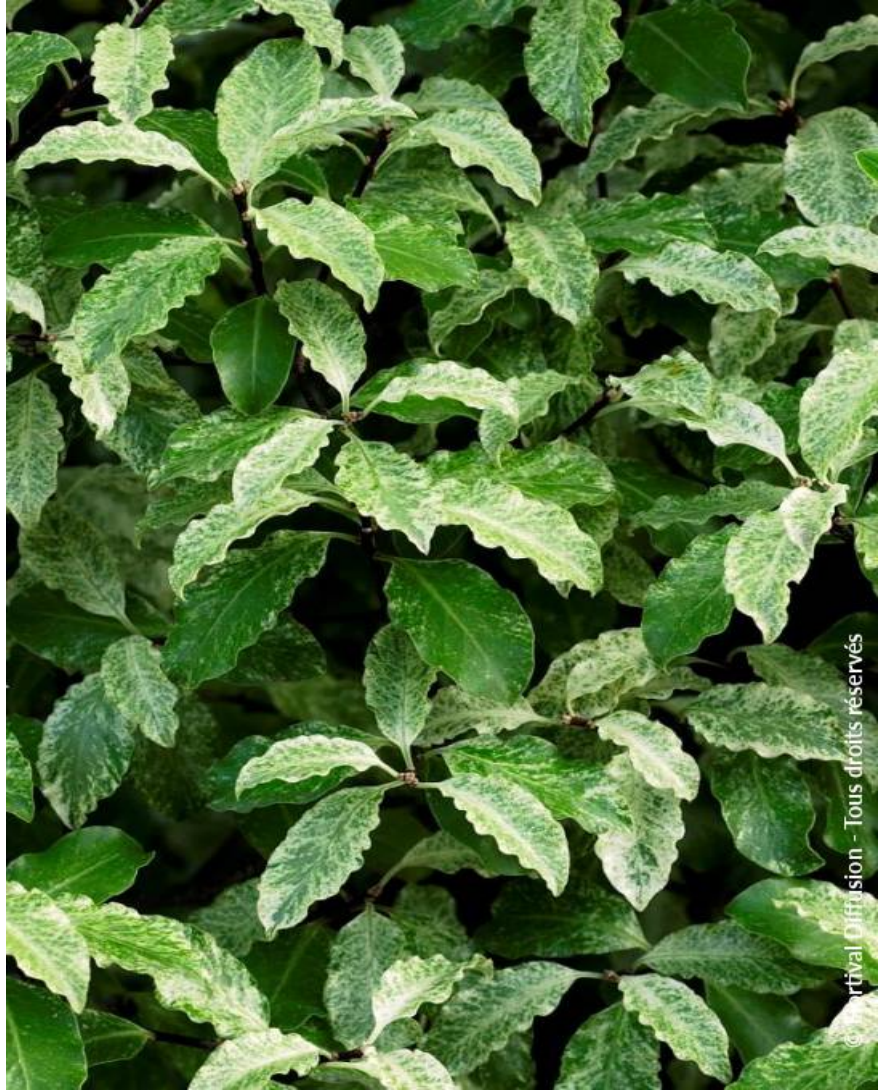
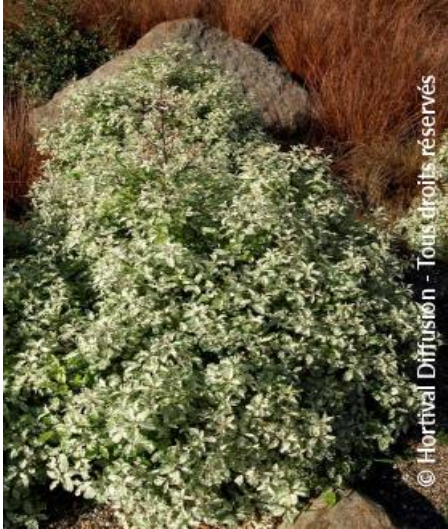


PITTOSPORUM tenuifolium 'IRENE PATERSON'

Evergreen shrub, young leaves white, green in summer, an excellent garden feature.



Maintenance advice: Pruning is rarely necessary, but can be done, moderately, at the end of winter.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: Found in the wild, by Grahame Paterson at Kennedy's Bush Reserve (NZ) before 1970



Use group: Mild Climate plants



Height at 10 years: 3 m
