Evergreen Spindle Tree, many-flowered spindle



**Maintenance advice:** Pruning is often unnecessary but can be done at the end of winter.



**Botanical/Horticultural origin:** West China : discovered by Augustine Henry and introduced by Ernest Wilson (GB) 1908
