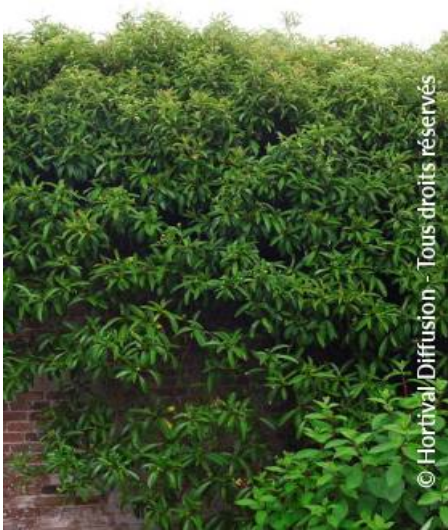


# PILEOSTEGIA viburnoides
