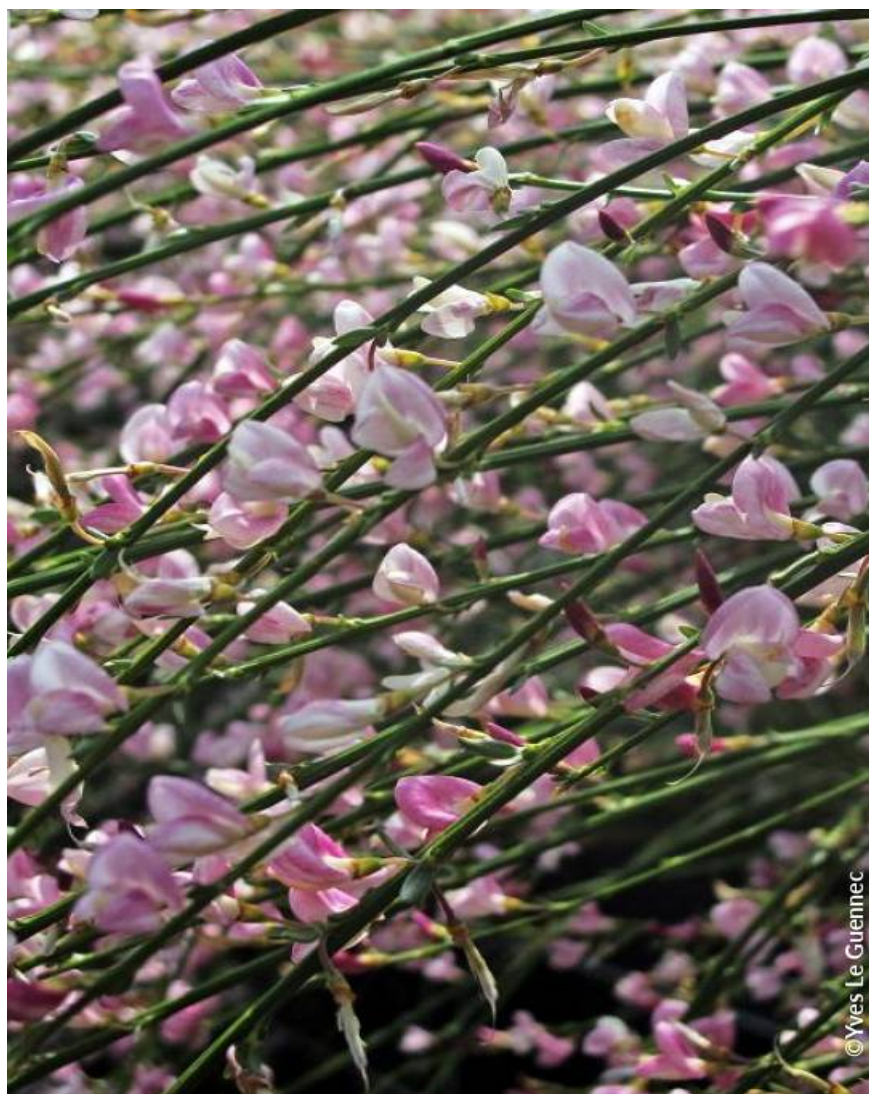
















CYTISUS SCOPARIUS 'MOYCLARE PINK'

-  **Maintenance advice:** After flowering, cut down branches up to 2/3 in length, to harmonize shape and to maintain compact. Take away any fruit pods, tiring the plant.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticulture
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** Yes

-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** White/pink
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Border, Free standing specimen, Rockery
