Upright berberis orange leaved in spring turning soft green in summer. Red autumn colour. Deciduous.

-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, shorten shoots from the previous year to keep compact and encourage lovely red, new shoots in the following spring. Can also be trimmed, after flowering, to preserve and harmonize shape.
