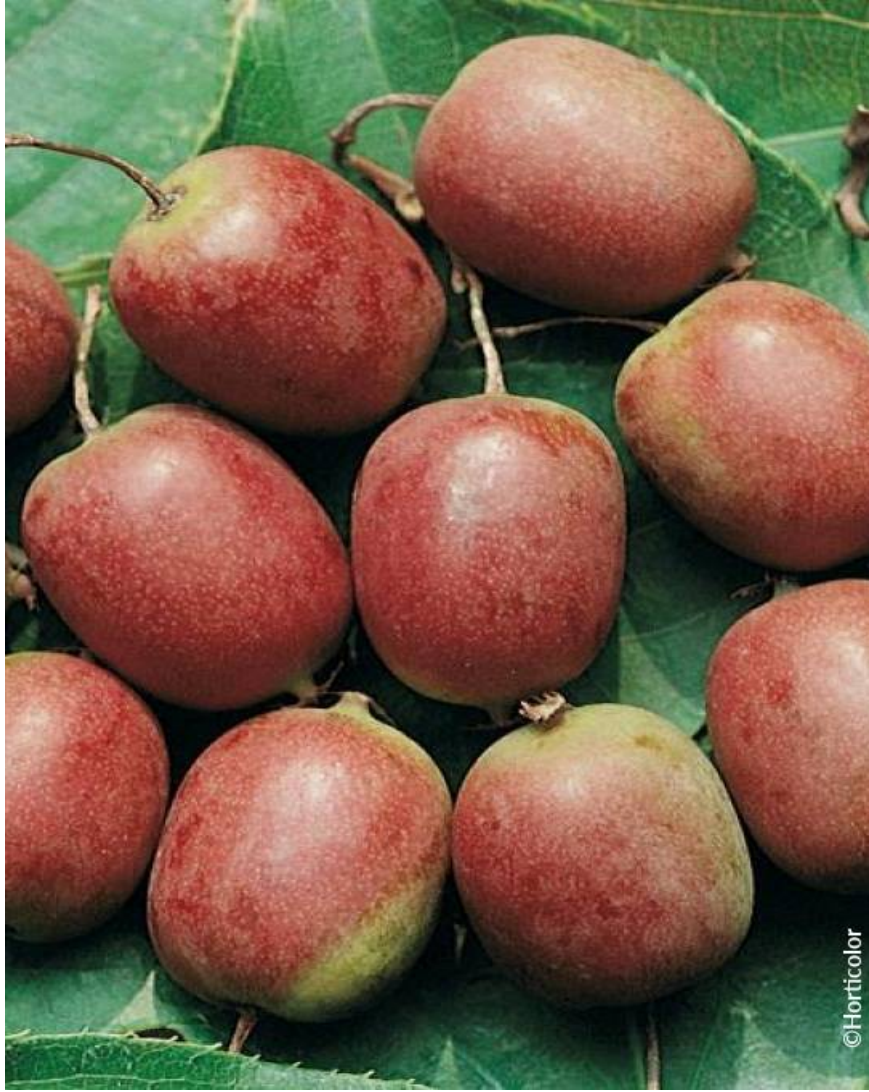


ACTINIDIA arguta 'Ken's Red' (FEMELLE)

Hardy Kiwi/Siberian Kiwi 'Ken's Red' Female



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, remove the secondary branches having borne fruit, and return its harmonious structure. Guide the new secondary fruit bearing branches, horizontally. In summer, reduce the growth of young shoots by pinching them, 2 leaves above the recent fruit bunches.
