Hardy 'mop head' hydrangea. Green leaves, very large blue flowers (in acid soil).

-  **Maintenance advice:** In April, remove the dead wood, the old grey stems and the withered flowers. Keep the young and vigorous stems (bearing large buds) and water regularly in dry weather.
